Doubling support to DRM in partner countries

In 2019, Luxembourg's overall assistance in support of domestic revenue mobilisation (DRM) reached USD 2.24 million, representing an increase of 52% compared to 2018 and a more than quadrupling since 2015. Luxembourg has therefore met the ATI commitment to double its ODA for DRM, which it first met in 2017. The main government department delivering these programmes is the Ministry of Foreign and European Affairs.

Luxembourg's programmes supporting DRM have all been delivered by multilateral organisations, including the IMF (support to the Revenue Mobilisation Trust Fund), World Bank (support to the Global Tax Program) and the OECD (support to the BEPS process and Tax Inspectors Without Borders), Administrations Fiscales and the Commonwealth Association of Tax Administrators.
